

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

9. Quote Southwild 25 augustus - 11 september

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In the morning, they can visit the howler monkeys, go on a boat excursion, and then, with the guide's assistance, choose between visiting either the Monkey Tower or the Jabirus Tower and stay there for as long as they'd like. After lunch, they can explore the walking trails. Before dinner, they have the option to visit the ocelot hiding place.

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Overnight at Wolf Valley Camp (-/-/D)

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After breakfast, we will embark on a 25 km, 50-min-long drive into the heart of the 1.7-million-acre Parnaíba River Headwaters National Park. Here, you'll have the opportunity to marvel at the stunning cliff scenery and seek out various bird species, including Burrowing Owls, Red-legged Seriemas, Greater Rheas, and nesting Blue-and-Yellow Macaws. In the evening, there's a good chance of encountering the beautiful and endangered Maned Wolf, which holds the title of the tallest wild canid in the world (though not the heaviest!).

Our accommodation for the night will be at SouthWild Wolf Cliffs Camp, the sole lodging within the national park. You'll stay in rustic but spacious bungalows, each equipped with en suite facilities.

Overnight at Wolf Cliffs Camp (B/L/D)

Day 3, 4 –Wolf Camp – August 27, 28, 2024

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Day 5, 6 –Wolf Valley Camp – August 29, 30, 2024

On this day, we will drive 30 minutes from WVC to a small rocky gorge to view up close a troop of world-famous Bearded Capuchins, which use their own specially-selected igneous hammer rocks to smash open the very same kind of rock-hard, nutritious palm nuts that the Hyacinth Macaws love to eat. Viewing these nut-cracking monkeys is yet another SouthWild exclusive and delights our visitors. This nut-cracking behavior is the world's most complex tool use by any monkey species.

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Overnight at Wolf Valley or Cliffs Camp (B/L/D)

Day 7 –Wolf Camp – Barreiras – Belo Horizonte – Cuiaba – August 31, 2024

After breakfast, a chance to enjoy wildlife such as the Tufted-eared Marmosets or the Celeus woodpecker near the camp and then transfer 3.5 h to Barreiras airport (BRA) for your return flight to Cuiaba (CGB) the return is through Belo Horizonte (CNF). We suggest Azul flight number 5023, which departs Barreiras (BRA) at 1050h and arrives at Belo Horizonte (CNF) at 1305h. Stop 1h30m, connecting with Flight number 4256, which departs Belo Horizonte (CNF) at 1435h arriving Cuiaba at 1550h.

Upon arrival, take the free shuttle to the Hotel Slaviero.

Overnight at Hotel Slaviero (B/-/-)

Day 8 – Cuiaba – Piuval - September 1, 2024

Breakfast and then leave the lodge to drive 1.5h to Pousada Piuval.

Pousada Piuval is located 110 km from Cuiabá and 10 km from Poconé - MT. It is the first inn on the Transpantaneira Highway.

It has an area of 7,000 hectares of land, and has one of the most beautiful natural landscapes in the Pantanal. There is a

diverse fauna and flora of the Pantanal, where tourists can observe and admire its biodiversity.

The tours will have a maximum duration of 2 hours, after this time, they will charge per hour, the tours will have pre-programmed departures and scheduled by the inn's reception depending on availability or weather conditions.

Overnight at SouthWild Pantanal. (B/L/D)

Day 11 : Southwild Pantanal - September 4, 2024

Breakfast. Activities at the lodge, particularly boat rides on the Pixaim River to see abundant birdlife and the Ocelot Experience, and now, a new attraction. Specifically, In February 2024, we inaugurated another SouthWild Global Exclusive, the SouthWild Howler Monkey Experience. There are 15 species of Howler Monkeys in the world, and they are distributed from southern Mexico to SE Brazil. Despite the huge distribution of these howler species, there is only one location where you predictably can watch any of the 15 species from up close, and that is SWP. In our case, the species is the beautiful Black-and-Gold Howler Monkey. On 9 out of 10 mornings, a family of these howlers shows up between 6:30 am and 8:00 am at specific trees, and we can view them from only 5-6 meters for 10-15 minutes. Each morning, our howler research assistants wait in the forest, and if they see howlers approaching, they radio to the lodge, and guests have to be ready to board a boat for a 4-minute ride followed by a 5 minute walk.

Day 12: SWP - JAGUARLAND- September 5, 2024

Observe abundant fauna around lodge, breakfast and around 7:00 am departure in open-sided, roofed Safari Truck or closed AC van (depending on the logistics of the day) to the end of road at Porto Jofre. Stops on Transpantaneira to see wildlife; arrive to end of the road by 10:00 am to take Jaguar search boats 16 km upstream to our flotels –the jaguar flotel in the middle of Jaguarland. Jaguarland represents 100,000 hectares, or one half of one percent of the entire Pantanal. The entire Pantanal is approximately 220,000 square km, which means about 50% the size of California. Lunch. At 2 pm, embark on a 4-h boat outing. Dinner, and then a unique SouthWild science lecture about favorite species of fauna of the Pantanal.

Overnight at Flotel.(B/L/D)**Day 13 : Jaguarland - September 6, 2024**

Breakfast. Two 4-4.5-h-long boat outings per day to search for Jaguars, Giant Otters, and other wildlife on some of these river channels: the Cuiabá River between Porto Jofre and the mouth of the Perigara River, the Upper and Lower sections of the Three Brothers River, the Caxirí Canal, the Canal de Carmindo, the Black Channel, and the lowest 40 km of the Piquirí River. Guests enjoy a large buffet lunch and dinner.

After dinner, a science lecture about Pantanal wildlife.

Overnight at Jaguar Flotel. (B/L/D)**Day 14: Jaguarland - SWP - September 7, 2024**

Breakfast, check-out, morning boat outing is also a slow, “Jaguar-speed” transfer 16 km downstream to Porto Jofre followed by 3-h-long road transfer to SWP in an open Safari Truck or closed air-conditioned vehicle.

Lunch (12:00 -13:30). Afternoon activity at the lodge.

Activities at the lodge are organized according to the current weather, logistics and your interests.

One forest walk and one boat outing per day are included.

Ocelot viewing in evening (one or the other of those delightful cats comes on 85% of the evenings).

29. Atlantisch regenwoud - Eco Lodge Itororo (Dag 3 arrangement - bezoek gouden leeuwaapjes)

30. Atlantisch regenwoud - Eco Lodge Itororo (Dag 4 arrangement)





2. Chapada dos Guimarães

Gelegen op slechts 64 km van Cuiaba in Mato Grosso, treft u het majestueuze nationale park Chapada dos Guimarães aan. Dit park wordt gekenmerkt door zijn hoge bergplateaus (600 - 800 meter), millennia-oude rotsformaties en grotten, spectaculaire watervallen, schilderachtige wandelpaden en een rijke diversiteit aan flora en fauna. TUSSEN-seizoen (april-juni): Na de regens vormen zich lagoons die een rijke voedselbron vormen voor watervogels. Het weer is milder en dieren worden actiever.

DROOG-seizoen (juli-oktober): Het ideale moment voor dierenobservatie, met velden die drogen en dieren die zich verzamelen rond waterbronnen.

REGEN-seizoen (november-december): Er valt veel regen, maar niet genoeg voor overstromingen. Dit seizoen is perfect voor vogelobservatie.

5. Paraty

De huisjes en hobbelige straatjes zijn nagenoeg identiek gebleven sinds de 17e eeuw. Een tour door Paraty is dan ook een reis door de geschiedenis van Brazilië.

Het historische dorpje Paraty ligt aan de kust op zo'n drie uur rijden van Rio de Janeiro en ligt midden op de route tussen Rio de Janeiro en São Paulo aan de 'Costa Verde', de groene kust. We bieden een prachtige self drive aan van Rio naar São Paulo, waarbij je Paraty aandoet. Uiteraard kunnen er ook transfers worden geregeld vanuit Rio. Vaak wordt Paraty gecombineerd met een bezoek aan Ilha Grande.

Paraty heeft een ruim aanbod aan bars, restaurants en er zijn tal van excursiemogelijkheden, zoals Schooner boottochten of met de kajak langs de vele mooie eilandjes voor de kust.



4. Chapada dos Guimarães - Pousada do Parque

Voor ontspanning zijn er faciliteiten zoals een zwembad, een veranda uitgerust met hangmatten, en een kleine fitnessruimte. Het Teta da Loba restaurant (prijzen gewonnen) biedt prachtige uitzichten en smakelijke, huisgemaakte gerechten bereid op een traditioneel houtfornuis.

Deze plek is perfect voor wie de alledaagse hectiek wilt ontvluchten en zich volledig wilt onderdompelen in de rust en schoonheid van de natuur. Daarnaast biedt de Lodge verschillende activiteiten aan zoals wandeltochten, vogelspotexcursies en avondwandelingen om de unieke flora en fauna van het gebied te ontdekken. De beste gastenkamers in de hele Pantanal zijn de 12 ruime kamers van Jaguar Suites, allemaal voorzien van vier meter brede, van vloer tot plafond reikende, schuifdeuren van glas die uitkijken op de wilde bossen van het beroemd om Jaguars rijke, 270.000 hectare grote Meeting-of-the-Waters Staatspark.

Flotel & Jaguar Suites zijn strategisch gelegen in het centrale deel van Jaguerland, 16-18 km per rivier van de meeste lodges in Jaguerland, dus geen tweemaal daagse reistijd naar de Jags. Je bent BIJ de Jags.

Beste Licht van de Dag Professionele fotografen genieten van Jags in het beste vroege licht en gouden, laatste licht van de dag op wilde rivieren nabij ons Flotel & Jaguar Suites. Geen vertrek van de Jags 30 min voor zonsondergang voor een zinloze, lawaaierige reis terug naar het drukke Porto Jofre.

12 kamers in Jaguar Suites (30 m² elk) en 8 kamers in Flotel (verschillende groottes, maar kleiner dan Jaguar Suites. Informeer bij naar de upgrade kosten voor Jaguar Suites kamers), allemaal met WIFI, gesplitste airconditioning en ensuite badkamers; Enorm, openlucht bovendek op Jaguar Suites flotel, met schaduwrijke eettafels, zonnebadgebied, barbecue, natte bar en toiletten voor vrouwen en mannen; Enorme, afgesloten, airconditioned eetzaal met panoramisch uitzicht op de wilde Piquiri Rivier en het Rhode-Island-grote beschermd gebied; Grote lezingenzaal voor de roulerende reeks van wildlife lezingen door onze inwonende naturalist over Jaguars, Reuzenotters, Kaaimannen en Capibara's; Gelegen in het midden van de 100 km van "Jaguerland", dus geen lange ochtend- of middagreizen naar de Jags, en zelfs privé Jags worden vaak gezien op de Piquiri; Geniet van het vroegste en laatste, gouden licht op de rivier en met de Jaguars (niet verspild in lange, lawaaierige, winderige boottochten van/naar Porto Jofre).

Wanneer SouthWild Flotel & Jaguar Suites te bezoeken Hoewel onze Jaguar bootbestuurders de grote katten het hele jaar door op de rivieren van Jaguerland zien, is er geen twijfel dat de beste maanden voor de Jags van juni tot november zijn. 6. Pantanal - Southwild Pantanal

De SouthWild Pantanal Lodge bevindt zich 2,5 km van de Transpantaneira Road, aan de beboste oevers van de Pixaim-rivier die rijk is aan wilde dieren. Met kamers voorzien van airconditioning en toegankelijke rivierbossen biedt SWP de beste waarde voor serieuze vogelaars, natuurliefhebbers en fotografen in de Pantanal. Ze bieden boottochten waarbij je de tamste Reuzenotters ter wereld kunt zien. Andere exclusiviteiten zijn de enige mobiele observatietorens in de Pantanal, strategisch gelegen bij vruchtdragende en bloeiende bomen, en stille, elektrische riviercatamarans voor fotografen die lange lenzen op statieven gebruiken. SWP biedt ook paardrijtochten, vee drijven, wandelingen op wetenschappelijk ontworpen bospaden, onderzoekslezingen, het spotten van zoogdieren, een sterrenkaart voor de studie van de spectaculaire nachtelijke hemel en Braziliaanse barbecues.

De lodge bestaat uit een grote, volledig afgeschermd woonkamer/eetkamer met veel plafondventilatoren, buitenzitjes en een bibliotheek over de Braziliaanse natuur. Elk van de twaalf afgeschermd gastenkamers heeft een eigen badkamer met warme douches, plafondventilatoren, airconditioning en een queensize bed of twee eenpersoonsbedden. Om plastic afval te vermijden, biedt de lodge nu gratis gekoeld drinkwater dat onbeperkt wordt verstrekt uit waterkoelers. Breng je eigen duurzame Nalgene-fles mee om bij te vullen.

De SouthWild Pantanal Lodge verbetert voortdurend zowel de hoeveelheid als de kwaliteit van de fantastische dierenobservaties. Je kunt het veld, het bos en de rivier op verschillende manieren verkennen: te paard, met boottochten, wandelingen op paden, mobiele observatietorens, elektrische fotocatamarans en nachtelijke spotlighting vanuit onze speciale vrachtwagen met speciale foto-logistiek. De laatste drie zijn uniek voor onze lodges - geen enkele andere lodge in de Pantanal biedt ze aan. Opvallend is dat de lodge de enige observatietoren ter wereld heeft bij een nest van de Jabirustork. Dit 12 meter hoge platform is toegankelijk via een gebruiksvriendelijke spiraaltrap. De top van de toren bevindt zich op het niveau van het nest, dat slechts 15 meter verderop is. Onze speciaal opgeleide natuurgidsen hebben deze ooievaars jarenlang gewend gemaakt, zodat de vogels nu volledig de gasten negeren en al hun meest intieme nestgedrag in volledig zicht uitvoeren.

Inbegrepen in de tarieven: Volpension accommodatie, inclusief ontbijt, lunch en diner. Toegang tot het Ocelot Observatorium. Gebruik van de wandelpaden. Toegang tot twee observatietorens; een op 16 meter van het Tuiuiú-nest, de enige in zijn soort op de planeet, en een andere aan de oevers van de Pixaim-rivier. Een twee uur durende boottocht per dag. Voor gasten die 3 nachten verblijven, is een gratis 2 uur durende safari met de truck inbegrepen. Assistentie van het team van de herberg in het Portugees tijdens de opgegeven tijden. Een tweetalige natuurgids is niet inbegrepen. Mocht u er een nodig hebben, vraag ons dan naar de extra kosten.

Wanneer de SouthWild Pantanal Lodge bezoeken

De SouthWild Pantanal is het beste te bezoeken van mei tot december, waarbij elke maand zijn eigen voordelen biedt. De favoriete maanden zijn juni, juli en november, omdat het dan koeler is en de lucht helder is, zonder nevel die bijvoorbeeld de fotografie kan verstoren als een jaguar op meer dan 50 meter afstand is. Vanaf augustus begint het warmer te worden, en september en oktober zijn de heetste maanden van het jaar.

Elk jaar tussen 20 juli en 1 september vindt er een spectaculaire concentratie van duizenden reigers, ooievaars, kaaimannen en capibara's plaats bij de bruggen op kilometer 17 van de Transpantaneira. De piek van dit natuurfenomeen valt gemiddeld op 12 augustus. Afhankelijk van de hoeveelheid regen in de maanden december tot maart kan dit spektakel twee weken eerder of later plaatsvinden.

De massale bloei van de gele cambará-bomen vindt plaats eind juni tot begin juli. De bekende bloei van de felroze trompetbomen (*Tabebuia rosea*) duurt meestal 10 tot 15 dagen in augustus. De cambará-bomen bloeien in 8 van de 10 jaren goed, terwijl de trompetbomen slechts in 4 tot 5 van de 10 jaren bloeien, wat het altijd een beetje een gok maakt als je tijdens de bloei van de roze trompetbomen wilt verblijven. Ocelotten zijn het hele jaar door te zien, maar jaguars zijn het beste te spotten van juni tot november.




De ruime eetzaal van de lodge biedt aan drie zijden plafondhoge schermen met onbelemmerd zicht op de omliggende bomen, velden en de Pixaim-rivier. Hierdoor kunnen overdag vele vogels worden gezien, zoals buff-halsibissen, Toco-toekans en kuifhokko's, en zoogdieren zoals capibara's, krabbenvossen, moerasreeën, reuzenotters, tapirs en soms zelfs een reuzenmiereneter of jaguar. De maaltijden worden in buffetvorm geserveerd, met een ruime keuze aan vegetarische en veganistische opties naast traditionele vleesgerechten. De eetruimte wordt gekoeld door een reeks plafondventilatoren.

Na jaren van ervaring met diverse koks, heeft SouthWild Pantanal nu de meest getalenteerde lokale chefs, die maaltijden bereiden die vaak beter zijn dan die in de beste restaurants van Cuiabá. De kwaliteit van de bereiding en kruiden overtreft ruimschoots die van andere lodges langs de Transpantaneira.

De lodge ligt op slechts 30 meter van de 70 meter brede Pixaim-rivier, die tussen juni en december stopt met stromen en meer op een meer lijkt dan op een rivier. Kaaimannen zonnebaden en schuilen onder de overhangende vegetatie langs de oever en worden regelmatig aangevallen door jaguars. In de nabijheid van de lodge zijn er 5 tot 6 verschillende jaguars die binnen 15 minuten varen langs de rivier kunnen worden gezien.

Het zwembad is klein, maar groot genoeg om baantjes te trekken. Het is ideaal voor een verfrissende duik tijdens de warme dagen. Van juni tot 20 augustus zijn de nachten koel, wat ook het water koel maakt. Tussen 20 augustus en 1 november is het Pantanal echter zo warm dat het zwembadwater vaak 28 graden Celsius of meer bereikt, wat uitnodigt tot lange, ontspannen baden.



7. Pantanal - Pousada Piuval

Kamertype: Standaard 2-persoonskamer

Maaltijd type: Volpension

Aantal nachten: 2

Aantal kamers: 1

Deze lodge ligt in de Pantanal aan de Transpantaneira. Dit is de onverharde weg die door dit prachtige natuurgebied gaat. Het is de eerste lodge die je tegenkomt op de Transpantaneira, dus het is op korte rijafstand van Cuiaba op ongeveer één uur rijafstand.

De 29 comfortabele kamers beschikken over airconditioning, minibar, plafondventilators, tv, wifi en een eigen badkamer. Tot de recreatieve faciliteiten behoren een zwembad, volleybalveld, speeltuin, mountainbikes en uitkijktorens. Gasten kunnen heerlijk ontspannen met een drankje aan de zwembad bar of in het restaurant genieten van verrukkelijke regionale Pantanal gerechten.

Er zijn diverse dagelijkse excursies zoals paardrijden, foto safari's, boottochten en wandeltours. In de omgeving kan je honderden soorten dieren, vogels en vissen zien.

Het verblijf is op basis van volpension met inbegrip van dagelijkse excursies en transfers van en naar Cuiabá.

Locatie:

Pousada Piupal ligt ongeveer 120 km ten zuidoosten van Cuiaba waar de Transpantaneira begint, een onverharde weg van 150 km die het hart van de noordelijke Pantanal doorsnijdt.

Om er te komen:

De transfer van Cuiaba naar de lodge duurt ongeveer 2½ uur. De route naar de lodge loopt langs Poconé, een 18e eeuws goudmijnstadje. Vanaf Poconé is de laatste 10 km langs de Transpantaneira, een onverharde weg. De laatste 3 km naar de lodge gaan door seizoensgebonden overstromingsgebieden, en daarom zijn 4x4 transfers bij alle arrangementen inbegrepen.

Grootte en structuur van de lodge:

Behalve dat Pousada Piupal zijn "Pantaneiro" roots als werkende veehouderij heeft behouden, is het een solide middenklasse lodge met 29 ruime kamers in twee categorieën: 20 Standaard Tuinzicht kamers (25m^2) met gedeelde veranda's, en 9 Deluxe Suites (36m^2) met privé veranda's voorzien van hangmatten die uitzien over de weilanden en uiterwaarden die de lodge omringen. Alle kamers zijn voorzien van split airconditioning, plafondventilatoren en douches met warm water. Met zijn aangename zwembad, speelkamer, biljart en kinderspeelplaats en volleybalveld is Piupal ook een zeer gezinsgerichte accommodatie. Het restaurant serveert maaltijden in buffetvorm en biedt een aangenaam uitzicht over de omliggende gazons, die zorgvuldig worden onderhouden door een familie capibara's, het grootste knaagdier ter wereld.

Unieke kenmerken:

Pousada Piupal is trots op een landgoed van 7000 ha dat een verscheidenheid aan landschappen omvat, van grasvlakten en intermitterende galerijbossen tot rivieren en lagunes. Hierdoor kunnen het hele jaar door boottochten worden gemaakt. Dit mozaïek van landschappen is een habitat voor een grote verscheidenheid aan wilde dieren, die tijdens de excursies uitgebreid aan bod komen. In het hart van deze natuurgebieden doorkruist een 450 m lange houten wandelbrug de moeraslanden naar een 15 m hoge uitkijktoren op een bosiland, de perfecte plek om de uitgestrektheid van de Pantanal te aanschouwen. De roze ipê boom, plaatselijk bekend als "Piuba" is een spektakel op zich en komt hier bijzonder veel voor, vandaar de naam van de lodge. Praktisch gezien ligt Pousada Piupal op slechts 120 km van Cuiaba en het feit dat de luchthaven van de stad in slechts 2 uur te bereiken is, kan van bijzonder belang zijn voor degenen die weinig tijd hebben.



8. Rio de Janeiro - Hotel Linx airport



Deze gunstig gelegen accommodatie in Rio de Janeiro bevindt zich op slechts 500 meter van de internationale luchthaven Antônio Carlos Jobim van Rio de Janeiro. Hotel Linx biedt gratis WiFi, een bar, een zwembad en een 24-uursfitnessruimte. Het centrum van Rio de Janeiro ligt op 15 km afstand.

Alle kamers zijn voorzien van airconditioning, een minibar en een 32" (81 cm) led-tv met kabelzenders. Elke kamer is uitgerust met een eigen badkamer met douche en warm water.

U kunt elke dag goed beginnen met een ontbijtbuffet met vers fruit, broodjes en vleeswaren. In het eigen restaurant worden zowel regionale en internationale specialiteiten als een breed scala aan drankjes geserveerd. Linx Hotel International Airport Galeão biedt een gratis 24-uursspendeldienst en beschikt over diverse schermen met vluchttijden.



9. Atlantisch regenwoud - Eco Lodge Itororo

Eco Lodge Itororo ligt op een eigen idyllische, echt bevoorrechte en rustige plek. Het is verstopt in een prachtige privévallei, met uitzicht op bergen en het omliggende ongerepte regenwoud. Dankzij een eigen netwerk van paden is het mogelijk om veel tropische soorten flora en fauna te zien binnen een korte wandeling van de accommodatie. Gelegen op een hoogte van 1200 meter boven zeeniveau, is er een perfect klimaat zonder behoefte aan airconditioning en zonder muggen in de kamers. De lodge biedt 8 suites en 2 hutten op 1200 meter hoogte, waar het klimaat aangenaam is. Er is een eetruimte, veranda en terras om te genieten van verse maaltijden met zicht op vogelvoeders. Wifi is overal beschikbaar. 's Avonds kan men op het terras bij de vuurschaal sterren kijken en luisteren naar het regenwoud.

Slechts 2,5 uur verwijderd van Rio de Janeiro, biedt Eco Lodge Itororó de mogelijkheid om volledig op te gaan in het tropische regenwoud en de prachtige bergen van de Serra do Mar. Dit is ideaal voor vogelpotten, wandelen, vogelfotografie en vele andere buitenactiviteiten voor iedereen die geïnteresseerd is in natuurhistorie, of gewoon voor een paar dagen wil ontsnappen naar een vreedzame plek.

De gezellige eetruimte, veranda en het terras zijn perfect om te genieten van vers bereide maaltijden terwijl men kijkt naar drukbezochte vogelvoeders die veel soorten kleurrijke tropische vogels aantrekken. Wifi is beschikbaar in alle kamers, de eetruimte, veranda en op het terras. Eco Lodge Itororó is een toplocatie voor vogelpotten. Er zijn meer dan 200 vogelsoorten waargenomen binnen het terrein van de lodge, waarvan 60 endemisch zijn voor het Atlantische Regenwoud.

10. Atlantisch regenwoud Costa Verde - Vila Mont lodge

Vila Mont beschikt over vrijstaande lodges voor twee personen, een centrale hoofdgebouw met keuken en verblijftruimte, een prachtige zeer vogelrijke tuin en een bosterrein erachter met een uitgebreide vogelrijkdom. Geniet er van het meest uitgebreide ontbijt van heel Brazilië. Het arrangement is op basis van halfpension, dus diner is ook inbegrepen. Het Ook kunt u in de lodge zelf eten klaar maken. Of de nationale cocktail Caipirinha. Er zijn verder twee natuurlijke zwembaden om in te zwemmen, met zulk schoon water dat je het kan drinken.

Het is opmerkelijk dat een dergelijke plek nog bestaat, relatief nabij de metropolen Rio de Janeiro en Sao Paulo. Beide steden zijn ongeveer 4 uur rijden, wat in Braziliaanse termen niet ver is. Vila Mont bevindt zich er precies tussenin, aan de Costa Verde, op het Caicara-schiereiland (Juatinga). Tijdens het verblijf kan de gids uiteraard ook een uitstapje inplannen naar het koloniale Paraty met zijn gezellige centrum met bars en restaurants.

Net over de berg, hemelsbreed op ongeveer 2 ½ km, ligt Saco de Mamangua, het grootste fjord van Brazilië, gezegd met oogverblindende stranden. Een stevige wandeling van ongeveer 2 uur brengt je hier naartoe.

Alles hier ademt puur natuur, inclusief een groente tuin, zonneboiler, meerdere open haarden, veranda's en terrassen, en natuurlijke zwembaden met kleine watervalen. Het zachte geluid ervan brengt je in een staat van diepe ontspanning. Het water, rechtstreeks afkomstig uit het kabbelende beekje, is zuiver en schoon (Boviswaarde ruim boven de 15.000). Wees welkom in Vila Mont!

1. Atlantisch regenwoud - Activiteiten Eco Lodge Itororo (zonder Mico)

Eco Lodge Itororó biedt een verscheidenheid aan activiteiten die zijn inbegrepen in het arrangement. voor een actieve vakantie in het tropische regenwoud en de bergen, zoals vogel spotten, wandelen, wildleven, vogel- en landschapsfotografie. Het biedt ook de perfecte omgeving voor buitenreizigers die willen genieten van de rust van de natuur. Activiteiten omvatten onder meer 'Rainforest Impressions', een begeleide tour om de Gouden Leeuwaapjes te zien (optioneel bij te boeken, van tevoren doorgeven), wandeltochten naar de Porcelet en het Trés Picos Park en vogelkijktours.

De ervaren natuurgids bespreekt met u exacte excursie volgorde bij aankomst en kan deze aanpassen op basis van uw wensen, bijvoorbeeld als u specifieke vogels wenst te spotten. Geef deze van tevoren door.

De paden bij Eco Lodge Itororó stellen bezoekers ook in staat op eigen houtje natuur te verkennen, inclusief een uitkijkpunt en een tuin met orchideeën en bromelia's. Er is een kans om vogels en fauna zoals toekans en tangaren te observeren. Zoogdieren spotten is uitdagend door hun schuwheid. Deze activiteit is minder geschikt voor mensen met mobiliteitsbeperkingen of ernstige gezondheidsproblemen.

2. Paraty - Vila Mont Lodge (Bird watching)

Tijdens het verblijf in Vila Mont heeft u de beschikking over een zeer goede natuur en bird guide, zoals bijvoorbeeld Chico, die tevens uw chauffeur is tot uw beschikking (inclusief). Dit is een lokale gids en zeer goede vogelaar, die de beste plekken kent en in overleg met u de komende dagen de excursie doelen kiest. Mocht Chico niet beschikbaar zijn, dan zijn er nog een aantal andere hele goede gidsen waaruit we kunnen kiezen.

U kunt daarbij kiezen uit het bezoeken van verschillende goede gebieden maar er is ook een mogelijkheid een reservaat met enkele zeldzaamheden in te gaan en te combineren met rafting (niet wild maar relaxed) door een natuurgebied. Dat is een betaalde excursie die je ter plekke bij kan boeken. Verder is er een kolibrietuin, met een bescheiden entreeprijs (die

soms niet eens gevraagd wordt) waar het zeer goed mogelijk is 6-9 soorten kolibries van zeer dichtbij te zien en/of fotograferen. Bovendien zijn er ook nog veel andere vogelsoorten te zien.

Door de centrale ligging tussen prachtige kusten en rijke natuurgebieden is dit een ideaal uitgangspunt voor meerdaagse arrangementen: Wandelen in en rond het historische plaatsje Paraty, een autorit langs de fraaie kust. (Een twee- of driedaagse trekking op het schiereiland Juatinga behoort ook tot de mogelijkheden (niet inclusief)).

Als fotografie uw hobby is maakt u hier de mooiste foto's van het historische Paraty, de kustlijn, het landschap en de vogels en andere dieren die u ziet. Een boottocht na een wandeling van zo'n 3 uurtjes brengt u langs de prachtige stranden en vergezichten van Saco de Mamangua (inclusief). U hoeft niet te speuren naar vogels, door de 'feeders' ziet u prachtige soorten rond uw vakantieverblijf. Chico kan u ook meenemen naar andere bijzondere plekken die wat hoger liggen in de Mata Atlantica. Meer dan 400 soorten zijn hier waargenomen, waarvan 100 alleen al in het Atlantische regenwoud voorkomen. De routes bevatten bezoeken aan verschillende leefgebieden via bospaden met een mogelijkheid om een grote hoeveelheid soorten te zien. De dagindeling wordt ter plekke besproken met de gids, waarin alle onderdelen aan bod zullen komen. Een dagje rust in Vila Mont is een must, om alle indrukken eens rustig op u te laten inwerken! Het is natuurlijk mogelijk om hier langer te verblijven, want U zult versteld staan wat deze omgeving U nog meer te bieden heeft!

Vogelsoorten rond Vila Mont:

Veel fraaie en interessante soorten in deze regio. Een beknopt overzicht in het Engels omdat de vogelboeken ook Engelse namen gebruiken: Rufous Tailed Jacamar, Puffbirds, Black Necked Aracari, Channel Billed Toucan, Piculets, Woodpeckers en Woodcreepers, Kingfishers (Ringed, Amazon and Green), Rufous Capped Motmot, Trogons (White-tailed, Collared, Black-throated,, Surucua, Blue-crowned), vele Kolibris (Hermits, Violet ear, Mango, Jacobin, Woodnymph, Hummingbird, Coquette, Emerald, Starthroat, Woodstar), Nightjars and Owls, Squirrel Cuckoo, Guira Cuckoo, Ani's, Parrots (Red capped, Scaly Headed, Blue Fronted), Parakeets (Plain, Yellow Chevroned, Orange winged, Mealy, Blue winged, Maroon bellied, White eyed, Golden capped, Peach fronted), Blue winged Macaw, Red shouldered Macaw, Doves and Pigeons, Guan's, Red winged Tinamou, vele roofvogels waaronder Caracara's en Swallow tailed Kite, Reigers en Ibissen, Antshrikes, Antvireos, Antwrens (waaronder de zeer lokale Black hooded Antwren), Antbirds, Gnatcatchers, Antpitta's, Manakins (Blue, Pin-tailed etc), Flycatchers en Kingbirds, Oropendola's, Oriole, Troupial, Marshbird, vele soorten Tanagers en heel veel andere kleine zangvogels.
